The 2019 Artist Lock-In will take place between Sunday 22nd September and Tuesday 1st October 2019. Artists will be required to commit to the entirety of the residency.

ArtHouse Jersey will provide all Artists with accommodation and meals between these dates.

Artists are required to travel to Jersey at their own expense or at the expense of a cultural organisation of their home jurisdiction. Participants must make necessary travel arrangements to arrive in Jersey by 15:00 on Sunday 22nd September, and to depart on or following Tuesday 1st October.

The professional facilitator team will review the applications and a shortlist may be invited for interview over Skype where we can find out in more detail about your practice and aspirations. Unfortunately we will not be in the position to provide feedback on the work submitted.

Terms and conditions for applicants:

Applications must be returned to Francesca Duncan francesca@arts.je by 18:00 (GMT+1) on Friday 31st May 2019. Late applications will not be accepted. There is no application fee.

After completing the application form, participants will receive an email confirming acceptance. No documentation will be required to be sent by ordinary post.

Artists will must be available for the whole duration of the Artist Lock In.

If Artists are offered a place on the Artist Lock In 2019 they must confirm their attendance within 21 days. Any successful applicants who cancel their attendance at the Artist Lock In 2019 with less than 6 weeks notice will be charged by ArtHouse for the cost of their place (£2,000) on the residency.

Artists are required to make their own travel arrangements to Jersey, Channel Islands, by 15:00 on Sunday 22nd September 2019 and to depart on or following Tuesday 1st October 2019.

ArtHouse will cover the cost of full board, shared accomodation and meals during the Artist Lock In. Artists are required to travel to Jersey at their own expense or at the expense of a cultural organisation of their home jurisdiction.

Any personal information will be held on our database and only used for operational purposes by ArtHouse. Your personal data will not be passed onto any 3rd parties unless you explicitly ask us to do so. If you contact us we reserve the right to keep a record of that correspondence and incorporate the information it contains into our database. We will retain your data in line with our data retention retention policy unless you request otherwise, subject to their being no legal or regulatory reason for retaining this information.
